

CHAPTER 11

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

10-11-11: HEIGHT LIMITATION EXCEPTIONS:

- A. Appurtenances: The height limitations contained in the zone regulations shall not apply to spires, belfries, cupolas, antennas, water tanks, ventilators, chimneys, or other appurtenances usually required to be placed above the roof level and not intended for human occupancy.
- B. Public Buildings and Churches: Public buildings and churches authorized in a zone may be erected to any height, provided the building is set back from each established setback line at least one additional foot for each foot of building height above the normal height limit required in the zone in which the building is located.
