

CHAPTER 4
MINORS; CURFEW

5-4-1: **CURFEW SPECIFIED; EXCEPTIONS:**

- A. Under Sixteen Years: It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of sixteen (16) years to be in or on any public street, park, square or any public place between the hours of eleven o'clock (11:00) P.M. and five o'clock (5:00) A.M. immediately following.
- B. Seventeen Years: It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of eighteen (18) years but over the age of sixteen (16) years to be in or on any public street, park, square or any public place between the hours of twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight and five o'clock (5:00) A.M. immediately following.
- C. Exceptions: The provisions above set forth shall not apply in those circumstances where said minor is accompanied by a parent, legal guardian, or any other adult person having the legal care and custody of said minor, or where the presence of said minor in the place is connected with or required by some legitimate trade, business, profession or occupation by reason of employment, inclusive of the time necessary for going to and returning from such place of business for employment in which said minor is engaged. 5-4-2: **ADULT PERMITTING VIOLATION:** No adult shall aid, abet, permit, or encourage any minor to violate this chapter. (Ord., 8-19-1980)

5-4-3: **PENALTY:** Any person in violation of the foregoing provisions shall be deemed guilty of a class B misdemeanor and, upon conviction, subject to penalty as provided in section 1-4-1 of this code. (Ord., 8-19-1980; amd. 2006 Code)
