

FRUIT HEIGHTS CITY PUBLIC NOTICE

Due to the resignation of Council Member George Ray, there is a vacancy on the Fruit Heights City Council. The public is hereby notified of the vacancy and the process by which the City Council will receive applications and act to appoint a registered voter to fill the unexpired term of the vacated office.

Anyone desiring to fill the vacant seat on the Fruit Heights City Council must be a registered voter and must have resided within the City for twelve consecutive months immediately prior to the date of appointment, among other qualifications described in UCA § 10-3-301.

Those interested in filling the vacancy on the Council should submit an application in person during regular business hours to the City Manager/Recorder or Deputy City Recorder by 12 pm on January 16, 2025. In addition to the application, candidates are encouraged to submit a letter including a statement of interest and summary of qualifications. The application can be found on our website at www.fruitheightscity.com or can be picked up at the city office. If you have questions, please contact the city manager at 801-546-0861.

In an open meeting on January 29, 2025, starting at 7 pm in the City Council Chambers at 910 South Mountain Road, Fruit Heights, Utah, the City Council will interview each individual who has submitted an application and who meets the qualifications for the office regarding the individual's qualifications and fitness for the office. In accordance with the procedures of UCA § 20A-1-510, the Council will then make the appointment to the vacated office.

The individual appointed by the City Council shall be sworn in on the date appointed and shall serve as a member of the Fruit Heights City Council for the remainder of the vacated term – until December 31, 2025.
