Launching the Recycle Program

Blue Carts Are Here - So, What Happens Now?

Ready

Blue recycle carts were delivered to every home in Fruit Heights - nearly 1,800 carts.

Set

Start placing cardboard, plastic containers, cans and paper in the blue cart.

GO!

Starting July 1, recyclables are picked up every other week. See map below.

Determining Your Recycle Day

For the purpose of the new recycling program, the city has been divided into RED and BLUE zones (or weeks). To determine the dates your recyclables will be collected, look at the map below. Find your home, and see if you are in a RED OR BLUE week. Then, look at the calendar on the reverse side to see the exact pick up dates for your home.

Your garbage days are not changing. If your garbage day has been on a Tuesday or Wednesday, it will still be the same Tuesday or Wednesday. Every single week.

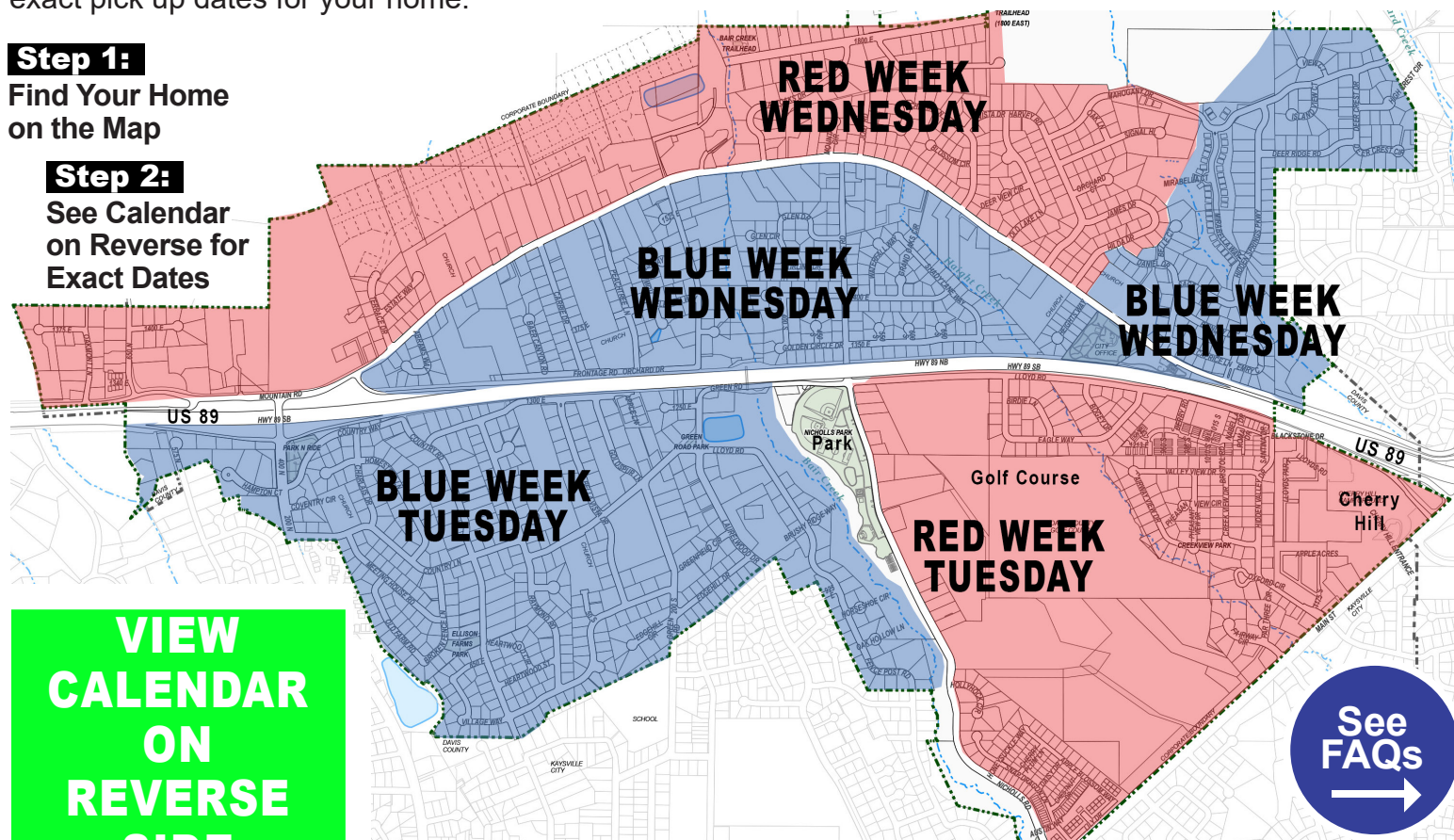
The new recycle program will pick up EVERY OTHER WEEK, on the same day of the week as your regular garbage pick up. See map and calendar to determine your collection date.

Q. WHY BRING A RECYCLE PROGRAM TO FRUIT HEIGHTS?

After conversations, a community survey and public hearing, the city council voted unanimously to bring a recycle program to Fruit Heights.

Q. CAN I OPT OUT OF THE PROGRAM?

No, this is a universal program, meaning it is now a basic service provided by the City, and anyone receiving City services will receive the bundled garbage/recycle collection program.

Q. HOW MUCH WILL THE PROGRAM COST?

All residents pay \$20.50 for garbage collection services. This includes one garbage cart emptied every week, and one recycle cart emptied every other week. The previous charge was \$15.50 for one garbage cart. This charge was to go up in July due to a rate increase from Wasatch Integrated Waste. By bundling services, the City was able to secure a lower rate. Residents will now pay the \$20.50 but receive two carts: one garbage, one recycle. Residents wanting additional garbage carts will pay \$15.50 per additional cart.

Q. I HAVE A CONTRACT WITH ACE RECYCLING. WHAT HAPPENS NOW?

We have worked closely with Ace. The ultimate goal of all parties involved is to promote recycling and divert recyclable materials from the landfill. Ace Recycling is aware of the change, and is ready to help. If you wish to cancel your contract with Ace, YOU MUST NOTIFY ACE. Once notified, Ace will immediately cancel your contract with no extra charge, and pick up their cart.

Q. DO I HAVE TO KEEP THE BLUE CART?

Every home received a blue recycling cart in June. If, after two months time, a resident doesn't want to keep and use the cart, they may request the City pick up the cart, but it will not change the monthly charge for garbage collection services.

Q. WHAT GOES IN THE CART?



Plastic bottles/containers, aluminum and steel cans, cardboard (flattened), newspaper, junk mail, paper. **NO GLASS** There are glass recycling locations located in Kaysville at Barnes Park and the library.
